Dogs at Jerry and Ben's Holiday Cottages

The 3 cottages share grounds and terraces, and we want to make sure all our guests enjoy the outside space here. We only allow pets in Mamie's Cottage, which has its own garden area and terrace, but it is not fenced in. Your dog will need to be on a lead in the garden and grounds.

If you think Mamie's will suit you and your pet and to ensure the cottage is kept to a high standard, please respect the following rules:

- Mamie's Cottage takes 1 well behaved small/medium dog
- Dogs must be well behaved, house trained and over 6 months old
- Dogs are not allowed on the furniture or upstairs in the cottage
- Guests must bring their own dog towels, blankets, beds and bowls
- Dogs must be clean and dry before entering the cottage use your own pet towels
- Dogs must not be left alone in the cottage at any time
- Clean up any evidence of your dog before you leave
- Dogs must be kept on a lead in our main Jerry and Ben's grounds below the cottages, next to the stream. This is shared with our other 2 (no dogs) cottages and children play here.

Out and About:

- Our local café The Old School Tearooms and our village pub The Clarendon are both dog friendly if you want to eat out in Hebden.
- There are lots of dog walks from the cottage: straight out the cottage door and over the
 moor track to Grassington, turn left and down the quiet road into Hebden or turn right and up
 onto the moors along the gill track.
- We are in farming country and sheep wander everywhere keep your dog under control.
- Leave no evidence in the cottage of your dog and always pick up any dog waste.

The cottages share terraces with low walls overlooking our grounds and stream.

Your dog must always be on a lead in the grounds and must not disturb your neighbours next door.
